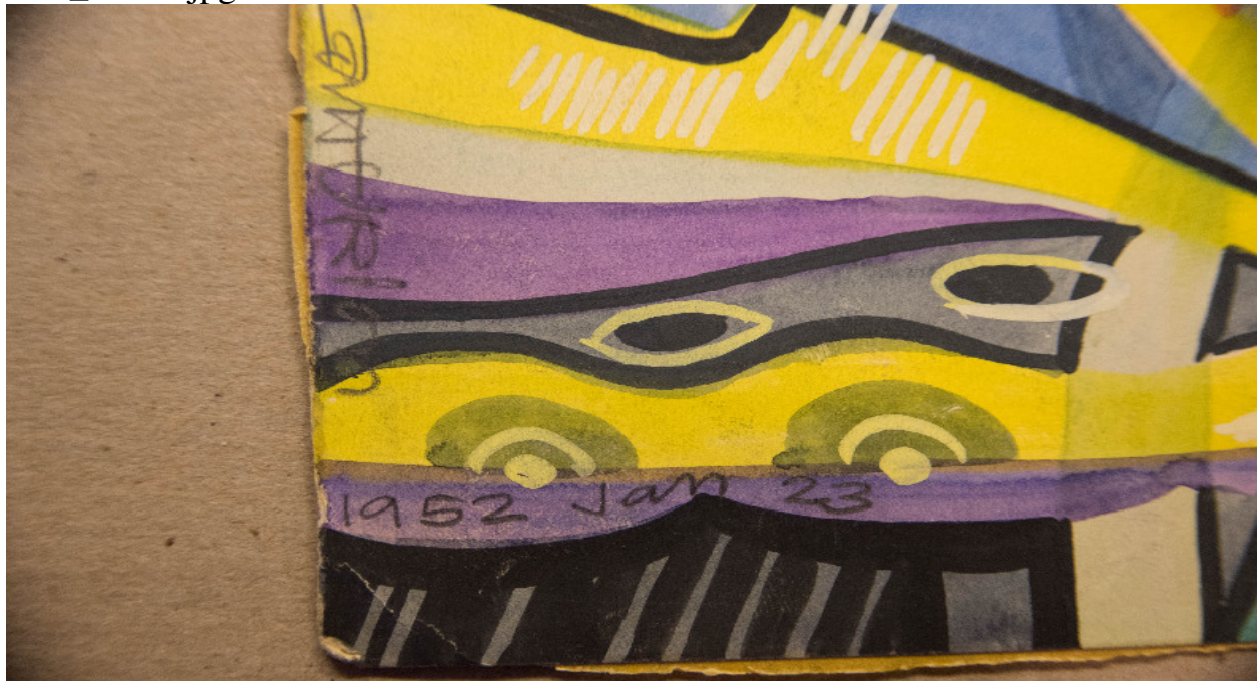

By way of some background: 8/22/2020 - Greg Root wrote:

I grew up in NYC and my father bought a number of Centurion paintings when I was probably in middle school. My dad had several copies of the 1950 Centurion painting list from the showing at the Brooklyn College Library that came with the group of paintings he bought (I have those lists now).

I believe my father acquired the artwork directly from the artist sometime in the 1958-1961 timeframe.

During the Vietnam war, I was stationed at Tinker AFB in Oklahoma and my wife and I were given a few of the paintings for our apartment. We had them framed in Oklahoma City in about 1973. When my mother moved into a nursing home in Riverdale (Bronx) in about 2013, we had to clean out her apartment and I brought the remaining Centurion paintings to our house in Connecticut.
